Visitors are coming to here.

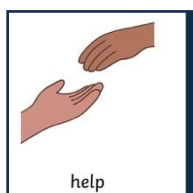
They want to see the great things we do.



The visitors are from Shared Care Scotland and the Short Breaks Team. Nicola works in the Short Breaks Fund.



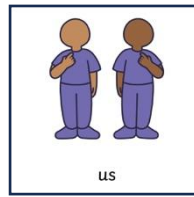
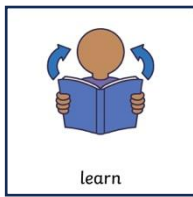
They help families have good breaks.



A short break means time to rest, relax, and have fun

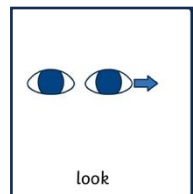
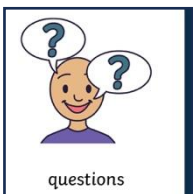

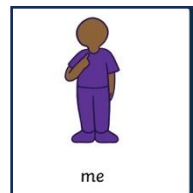
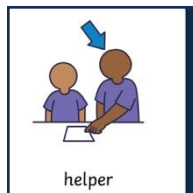


The visitors want to learn about our project and what we do here.

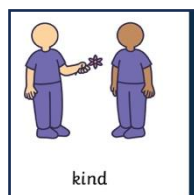
They may ask questions and look around.



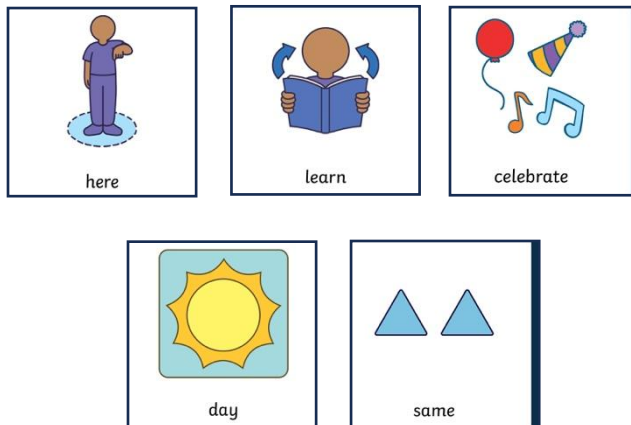
They might talk to the helpers, families, and sometimes children — maybe me.

Our day will be the same.

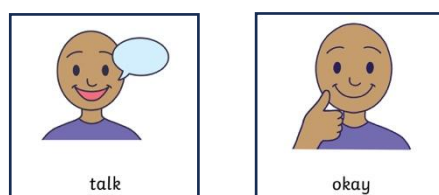


Visitors might watch, smile, and write notes.



If a visitor talks to me, that is okay.

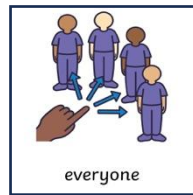
